## Preseason Notebook

• Akron returns four starters and 13 letterwinners from its 2008-09 team, which posted a 23-13 record (10-6 Mid-American Conference), won its first-ever MAC tournament championship (first No. 5 seed to do so) and made its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 1986 (school's only other appearance).

• UA faces the challenge of replacing 1,000-point scorer **Nate Linhart** (forward) in its lineup – the only scholarship player who does not return in 2009-10. The league's defensive player of the year, conference tournament MVP and honorable mention all-league pick, Linhart led UA in rebounding (6.2 rpg/10th in MAC), steals (1.7 spg/third in MAC/116th nationally) and minutes (29.9 mpg). He ranked second in scoring (10.3 ppg/18th in MAC) and blocked shots (18/0.5 bpg). Linhart finished his collegiate career with 1,023 points, 628 rebounds, 186 steals and a school-record 134 games played on his resume.

• A key component to the Zips' success last season came from the combined forces of brothers **Chris** (senior, forward) and **Brett McKnight** (junior, forward). Brett finished 2008-09 as UA's leading scorer (11.2 ppg/15 in MAC) and earned MAC Sixth Man of the Year, All-MAC Second Team and MAC All-Tournament Team honors. Chris received honorable mention all-league recognition and finished second on the squad in rebounding (4.7 rpg) and third in scoring (9.2 ppg/30th in MAC). He logged 25 starts in 36 games played.

• MAC All-Freshman Team choice **Anthony "Humpty" Hitchens** returns after starting in 30 of 35 games played as a rookie. Slowed in the MAC and NCAA Tournament due to a left ankle sprain, Hitchens averaged 8.8 ppg, 2.2 apg and 1.3 spg.

• Sophomore guard **Ronnie Steward** has completely recovered from surgery in December on his right leg due to compartment syndrome. He logged time in the first six contests (three starts) of the 2008-09 campaign, before being sidelined.

• The lone newcomer to the Akron roster in 2009-10 is 7-foot center **Zeke Marshall**. The consensus top-100 recruit and Rivals.com's highest-ranked player to ever commit to a MAC school, Marshall averaged 14 points, nine rebounds and eight blocked shots as a senior at McKeesport High School in McKeesport, Pa.

• UA closed out 2008-09 ranked among the top 100 nationally in a number of statistical categories – fifth in 3-point field goal percentage defense (29.1 percent/first in MAC), 10th in turnover margin (+4.0/first in MAC), 20th in scoring defense (60.3 ppg/third in MAC), 39th in field goal percentage defense (40.3 percent/second in MAC), 56th in scoring margin (+6.4/first in MAC), 80th in steals (7.5 spg/fourth in MAC) and 80th in 3-point field goals made (7.2/first in MAC).

• In his five seasons at Akron, head coach **Keith Dambrot** has led the Zips to 115-51 (.693) record. That win total is the most among MAC schools and the 28th highest nationally during that time. His win percentage and win total both rank fourth in program history.

• Akron has enjoyed four-straight 20-win seasons (23-10 in 2005-06, 26-7 in 2006-07, 24-11 in 2007-08, 23-13 in 2008-09). In 2004-05, the team went 19-10.

• UA has advanced to the postseason in back-to-back and three of the last four years, participating in the NCAA Tournament in 2009 and National Invitation Tournament in 2008 and 2006.

• The Zips have appeared in the MAC tournament championship game three-straight times, with those being the only three appearances in their 17 years in the league.
